



Car Learner's Licence: Road Code & Road Safety

A course to help you learn the Road Code in preparation to sit the Learner Driver's Licence Test.

(Help with reading can be given if required.)

To be eligible you:

1. Must be over 16 years old and may be in full time education.
2. Must be able to provide some form of primary identification e.g NZ Passport, NZ Birth Certificate, NZ Firearms Licence when applying for the Learners Licence.

To enrol:

Call into the CKC REAP Centre, 115 Hakiha Street, Taumarunui with your \$14 deposit (or \$94 total fees).

A place on the course will not be reserved for you until the deposit is paid. Get in quick this is a popular course!

Documents needed for sitting the Theory Test:

Before you can apply to sit the test the AA agent **must** see the following documents. They **must** be the **original documents** - photocopies will **not** be accepted.

1. **Primary Identification** - You must provide **one** of the following:
 - A full A4 sized Birth Certificate (issued in NZ, Cook Islands or Nuie
 - or your Passport (NZ or Overseas; current or has expired within the last two years)

2. **Proof of Address** - You **must** provide one of the following
 - Any official typed letter which clearly shows your name, address (postal or physical) and an issue date no older than 6 months.
 - Examples - bank statement, bank account, power bill, phone bill, rates assessment, pay slip, school letter, Work and Income letter etc.

3. **Plus, if you changed your name:**
 - **You are married and changed your family name:**
Provide your original Marriage Certificate, or Civil Union Certificate
 - **You are divorced, and want your licence back in your maiden name:**
Provide your original Marriage Certificate or Dissolution of Marriage Order.
 - **You are adopted:**
Provide your Adoption Papers
 - **You changed your name for other reasons:**
Provide your Statutory Declaration of Change of Name issued by Births, Deaths and Marriages

Please bring these documents to the first session.

They will be checked to see if they are correct for your application to sit the test; then returned to you immediately. Keep them safe and together until you are ready to sit the Theory Test once the course has finished.

If you do not have the correct identification, you may have to send away for a Birth Certificate. This will incur costs and can take several weeks to receive - do this **now** if needed.
